Rebel Bloze Native American Heritage Month: Indigenous Metal Musicians

ROB TRUJILLO (Metallica, Suicidal Tendencies, Ozzy Osbourne) Famous metal bassist Rob Trujillo is proud of his indigenous heritage. His ancestors are Puebloan, a tribe of Native peoples that resided in the areas of Colorado, Utah, Arizona, and New Mexico.




JOEY BELLADONNA (Anthrax)

Anthrax's Joey Belladonna is indigenous on his mother's side of the family, specifically the Iroquois tribe. Belladonna sang the famous track "Indians" about being Native on the band's most famous album

Among the Living.



Testament singer Chuck Billy is a descendant of the Pomo tribe. He has spoken about spending much of his childhood on a reservation, and has written & published songs through Testament about being Native.




JIMI HENDRIX

Famous guitar god Jimi Hendrix has stated that his grandmother was Cherokee, along with stating that he had African heritage as well. He showed pride in his heritage through some of the clothes that he wore on stage. Like Chuck Billy & Joey Belladonna, he has sung about being Native in songs such as "Little Wing" and "I Don't Live Today."

MARK FARNER (Grand Funk Railroad)

Farner founded hard rock band Grand Funk Railroad in 1969, and helped to influence heavy metal in the 1970s. He has Cherokee ancestry on his mother's side, and has been honored by the Cherokee Honor Society with the Cherokee Medal of Honor.





LINK WRAY

Hardly anybody knows Link Wray, but he is regarded as one of the most important guitarists in music history. Wray, who was Shawnee, popularized the power chord, which is now a staple in rock, punk, & metal alike. Without the power chord, rock, punk, and even metal would not even exist in the first place.

MUSQWAUNQUOT "MUSKY" RICE (Biipiigwan) Musky, as he is known, from sludge metal band Biipiigwan, is proud of his Anishinaabe ancestry. He uses the Ojibwe language in his music, and the band is heavily influenced by the culture of the Anishinaabe tribe. Biipiigwan released their single full-length album, Something for Everyone; Nothing for Anyone, in 2013, and have not released anything since.



JON KRIEGER (Blackbraid)

Krieger, who is the sole musician of the black metal project Blackbraid, comes from upstate New York. He is a descendant of the Mohawk tribe, and he is also known by his pseudonym, Sgah'gah'sowah, which means "the witch hawk" in the Mohawk language. Blackbraid is inspired by the classic sounds of Scandinavian black metal.

NOTE: Biipiigwan MAY have more than one (1) indigenous member. All I could find was an interview of Musky (Biipiigwan) stating that he is Anishinaabe, but I have not found anything else saying that any of the other members are Native.


